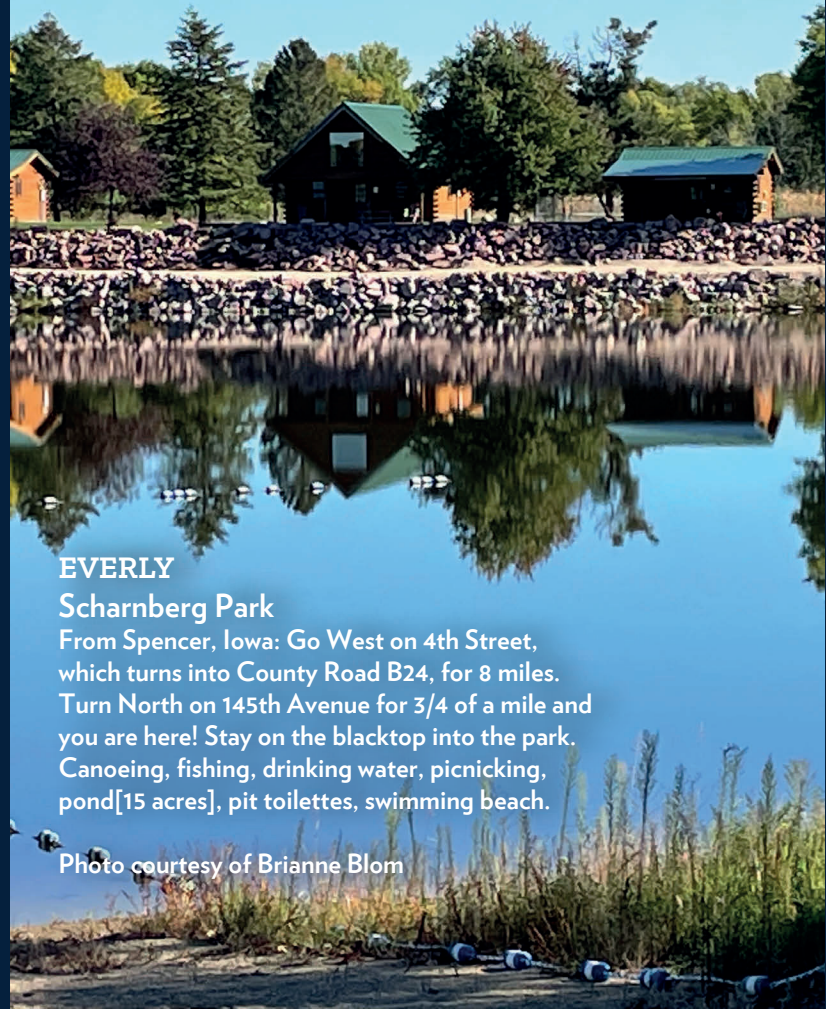

School programs, adult classes, family events and summer camps are offered.
